There are many new skills and activities introduced in third grade. At this level, students will now have nightly homework assignments and some more involved "projects" for science. The time you give to your child is the most valuable gift you will ever give to them.

Measure using standard and metric units

Appreciate local history and national figures

Conduct simple scientific investigations
