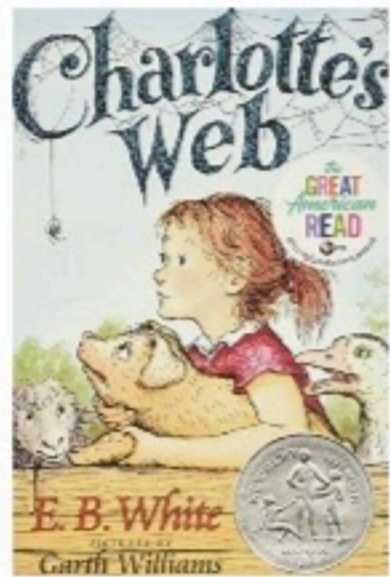

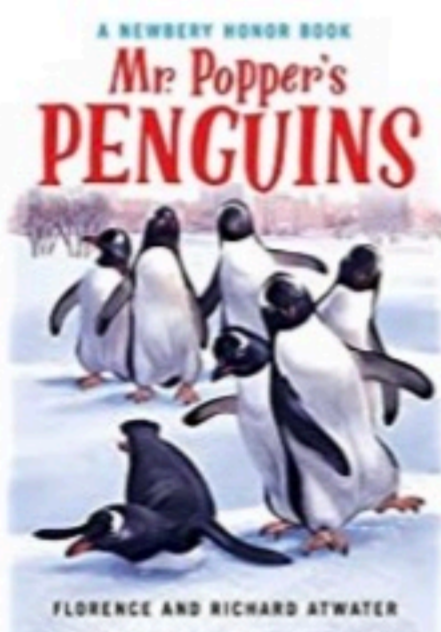


4th Grade: Charlotte's Web By: E.B. White

Book Description:

Winner of the Newberry Honor Book Award

The novel tells the story of a livestock pig named Wilbur and his friendship with a barn spider named Charlotte. When Wilbur is in danger of being slaughtered by the farmer, Charlotte writes messages praising Wilbur such as "Some Pig" and "Humble" in her web in order to persuade the farmer to let him live.



5th Grade: Mr. Popper's Penguins By Florence and Richard Atwater

Book Description:

Winner of the Newberry Honor Book Award

It tells the story of a poor house painter named Mr. Popper and his family, who live in the small town of Stillwater in the 1930's. The Poppers unexpectedly come into possession of a penguin, Captain Cook. The Poppers then receive a female penguin from a zoo who has 10 baby penguins.

Number the Stars is a work of historical fiction by the American author Lois Lowry about the escape of a family of Jews from Copenhagen, Denmark, during World War II. The story centers on 10-year-old Annemarie Johansen, who lives with her mother, father, and sister Kirstie in 1943, Copenhagen Denmark.
